Her publications include *Student Activism in Malaysia*: *Crucible, Mirror, Sideshow* (Cornell SEAP, 2011) and the forthcoming *The Roots of Resilience: Party Machines and Grassroots Politics in Southeast Asia* (Cornell University Press). Current projects include collaborative studies of "money politics", urban governance and public-goods delivery, as well as democratic representation and political elites in Southeast Asia, and a monograph on Malaysian sociopolitical development.
